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#### STEP 1: Confirm the fit

Visit: **thegreasebox.com/compatibility** to check the fit. The GX-G is for Wood Pellet Grill models with a side grease spout needing a "Slim Fit". Compatible with Green Mountain Grills, Camp Chef, Camp Chef Sidekick & others.

### STEP 2:

Make sure grill is turned off & cooled.

## STEP 3: (Image A & B)

Remove grease bucket and any potential interferences including side shelf (#10), shelving support (#11) and accessories (eg: side burners) for proper install.

Clean grease spout and grill area.

**Note: Green Mountain Grill** Shelf & shelving support can remain on if they are held in the upwards position for duration of install. Do not install with support shelving hanging downwards.

#### STEP 4: INSTALL (Use Image B)

Add Screws (#2) & (#14) to Top Hat.

**Note:** Alternate Screw (15\*) is ONLY for Top Weld Nut (#13) for grills with a short grease spout.

Slide Top Hat (#1) over the grease spout. Make sure the Top Hat sits flush against the side of the grill.

While pushing upwards, use a Screwdriver to hand tighten Screws (#2) and (14 or 15\*) to the grease spout.

Alternate between each screw making sure the screws arrive at the spout at the same time.

If screws are uneven, the Top Hat (#1) will not sit flush to grill.

Make adjustments as needed. Then, synch screws tight. When complete, the Top Hat (#1) should be level and not move.







Self-Tap Screw provided for hole #12, only if needed or preferred.



## STEP 4: CONTINUED (Image B)

Choose Lock (#7) placement location (Front or Back). Attach in order: Shoulder Screw (#5), Washer (#6), Lock (#7), Washer (#6). Then, advance into screw hole on lower portion of Top Hat (#1) until tight. Synch tighter to reduce swivel of Lock (#7).

Set Top Cover Plate (#4) within opening of Top Hat (#1). Secure in place with Screws (#3).

\*Recommended: (Image C) Add SBL-1 Silicone Box Liner (#9) or foil liner (Sold Separatley) into the Lower Bucket (#8) for cleanliness prior to grilling.

# STEP 5: ADD LOWER BUCKET (Image D)

Swivel Lock (#7) upwards.

Slide the Lower Bucket (#8) into drawer rails as shown. Push it all the way back and rotate Lock (#7) down.

# STEP 6: RE-INSTALL ACCESSORIES AND/OR SIDE SHELF

After install of The Grease Box, re-install side shelf (#10) and shelving support (#11) and/or accessories back into its place.

At this point The Grease Box is fully installed and ready for use.
