STEP 1: PREPARATION

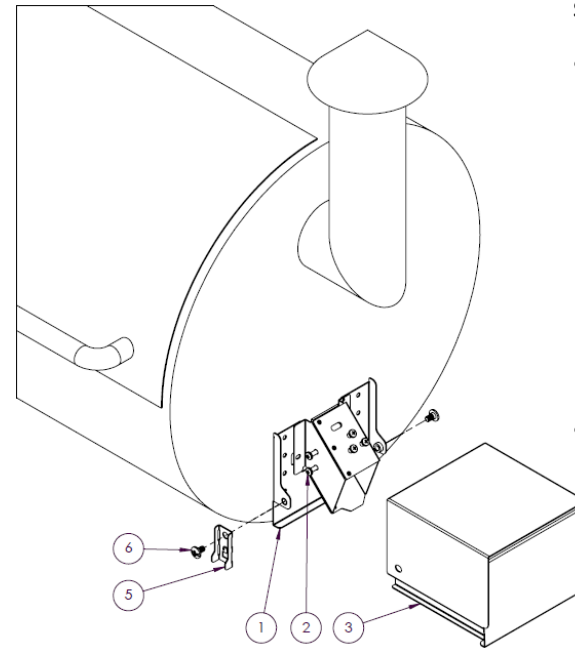
- Go to THEGREASEBOX.COM to confirm compatibility to your grill before proceeding with the installation.
- Make sure grill is turned off and cooled.
- On your grill, clean entire grease spout with non-abrasive cloth, including 4 inches in each direction on the flat vertical surface. This will ensure Mounting Plate (#1) can be properly mounted tight to grill. Cleaning can be accomplished with soap and water.

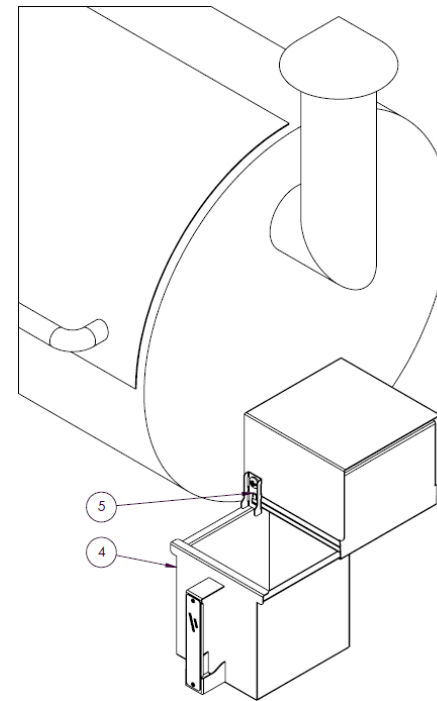

STEP 2: INSTALLATION



- Place Mounting Plate (#1) around grill spout as shown, applying upward pressure to hold it tight to grill. Using a screwdriver, tighten all Mounting Screws (#2) to make a firm connection with the grill. *If your grill has a spout that this method of mounting will not work on, then refer to back page of this document.*



- Hang Top Cover (#3) on Mounting Plate (#1) by aligning the center of them, pushing the Top Cover back tight to the grill and lower it down until it hooks onto the Mounting Plate. If done correctly, it will be level and semi-locked into position.
- Fully lock it into position using both Shoulder Screws (#6) and attach the Lock (#5) nearest the front side of the grill. The Lock should dangle and be able to be rotated upward setting against the side of the grill to remain out of the way for sliding the drawer in.
- Take the Sliding Drawer (#4) and install it as shown, with the handle towards the front of the grill. Push it all the way back and rotate the lock down. *Optional: Install Sliding Drawer with the handle and Lock towards the back of the grill if preferred.*
- At this point The Grease Box is fully installed, locked, and ready for its first cook. *It's recommended to empty grease contents after every use.*
